Unexplained fatigue/malaise

Chills and/or body aches

Headache

Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or abdominal pain.

2. In the past 14 days, have I been in contact with someone who tested positive?

(or is currently being tested) for COVID-19?

3. In the past 14 days, have I been in contact with someone who exhibited any symptoms related to COVID-19?

If you answer yes to any of these possible COVID-19 signs or symptoms, you should stay home and rest(or seek medical attention if symptoms are particularly bad or persist).
